

Collections Guide: What can we collect for our Pop Up Shop?



Thank you for supporting Crisis by hosting your own DIY Pop Up Shop!

To help ensure your fundraiser is a success, we advise you put out a call to collect the following good quality items:

- Men's, women's and unisex clothing for all seasons
- Accessories including shoes, bags, hats, scarves etc.
- Jewellery
- Homeware and gift items



TIP: In terms of quality, as a rule of thumb, if you'd want them in your own home, they're good to donate! To help advertise your collection, we've also put together a printable poster as a part of this pack.



We'd also advise against collecting the following items, as any leftovers are generally not accepted in charity shops. Please avoid:

- Childrens' books
- Used bed linen and towels
- Heavily used kitchen items - saucepans, plates, cutlery etc.

Please DO NOT collect or sell:

- Knives and age-restricted products



What to do with any unsold items afterwards?

Crisis shops would be more than happy to receive any items remaining unsold from your Pop Up to help towards our fundraising.
